PRESS NOTE

20<sup>th</sup> March, 2024: The term of 17th Lok-Sabha is due to expire on 16th June, 2024. The Election Commission of India on 16<sup>th</sup> of March, 2024 has announced the schedule for 18<sup>th</sup> Lok Sabha Elections, 2024. The Model Code of Conduct is enforced in the West Karbi Anglong, District with the rest of the nation where General Election to the Lok-Sabha 2024 is to be held. The West Karbi Anglong, District Election Office has made a comprehensive preparedness for the conduct of elections to the 18th Lok-Sabha in a free, fair, participative, accessible, inclusive, transparent and peaceful manner.

Following is the schedule for the forthcoming election for 111- Rongkhang (ST) LAC and 112-Amri (ST) LAC, a segment of 6-Diphu (ST) PC.

**ELECTORAL ROLL DETAILS:**

As per the final E-roll which was published on 8<sup>th</sup> February, 2024, West Karbi Anglong has 2,25,206 electors of which 1,28,664 are from 111-Rongkhang (ST) LAC and 96,542 from 112-Amri (ST) LAC. There are 1346 nos of 85+ Electors and 386 nos of PwD Electors. Through an extensive SVEEP campaign in the district, 4694 nos of young voters (18-19 yrs) have been enrolled in the Final Roll.

**POLLING STATIONS DETAILS:**

There are 312 nos of Polling stations across West Karbi Anglong district. (RONGKHANG LAC-172 Polling Stations and AMRI LAC-140 Polling Stations) The polling stations have been divided into 10 zones and 54 sectors. Out of the 312 nos of Polling stations, 15 nos of PS have been earmarked as All Women Polling Stations and 6 nos as Model Polling stations.

**PREPARATORY DETAILS:**

The District Election Officer has constituted different Election Cells for smooth conduct of the General Election. Polling personnel's for 312 nos of polling stations have been on boarded through first level randomization. The trainings of Polling personnel's have commenced and subsequent trainings will be undertaken shortly. The Flying Squad teams and Static Surveillance teams have been dispersed throughout the district for anti-defacement and surveillance for ensuring Model Code of Conduct. Meeting has been conducted with the HODs of different departments, Political parties for effective implementation of Model Code of Conduct.

**EVM AND VVPAT DETAILS:**

Arrangements have already been made to ensure availability of adequate number of EVMs and VVPATs for the smooth conduct of elections.

**Security Plan**

From security point of view West Karbi Anglong district have been divided into numbers of sectors and zones. The sectors will be headed by a sector officers of SI/ASI rank and the Zones will be headed by a DSP/Inspector ranked zonal officer. Apart from the existing force in the district, additional Coys of CAPF/SAP have been sought from outside the district for deployment in connection with the election.
